The Thirteenth national **Jerusalem Women Speak: Three Women, Three Faiths, One Shared Vision** tour organized by Partners for Peace focuses on communities in the US heartland.

The tour will feature the voices of **Huda Abu Arqoub**, **Tal Dor** and **Amal Nassar**. These three women - Muslim, Jewish, and Christian - are living the realities of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. They come to the United States to call for an end to war and suffering in the Middle East and share their experiences and hopes for a just peace with American audiences.

These women are working professionals, activists, mothers, daughters, and partners, all involved in their own way in resolving the conflict and charting a brighter future for their region. They have made a commitment to address American audiences about their hopes for the future and what must be done to improve today's deteriorating situation.

These three women will address realities of the conflict. They are here to demonstrate that peace, while difficult, is possible.

Tal Dor: A Jewish Israeli, Ms. Dor is a community activist focusing her work on underprivileged communities and forgotten narratives in Israel and Palestine

Amal Nassar: A Christian Palestinian, Ms. Nassar is a Nurse and a grassroots organizer developing nonviolent responses to war and occupation in the Bethlehem region.
